

# What to do Instead

- Make an annual habit of reviewing your school's entire website
- If time is short, focus on admissions-driven pages before each new recruitment cycle starts and carve out time throughout the year for other updates
- If your school experiences new hires and staff departures at a predictable time, that's a good time to make any updates to contact information that may be needed

- Increasingly frustrating brand experiences.


# What to do Instead

- Attach emails to people

The Inquiry Form is Too Long

# **Anatomy of a Strong Inquiry Form**

- Brief and distraction-free
- Friendly intro language
- Sticks to the basics what do you really need to know about a family this early in the process?
- Layout is everything stick to one column
- Good use of white space
- CTA is clear and action-oriented



**Barriers to Engagement** 

### Do:

- Have clear calls to action that take people to forms for completing actions like RSVPing for an admission event or submitting an inquiry
- Make it easy to schedule tours with a tool like Calendly or Hubspot
- Have web pages linked to information within your website
- Put FAQs front and center
- Allow families to create profiles in your application system when they're ready for that step

### Don't:

- Ask people to send an email and wait for a response to complete these actions
- Ask people to play email tag to gauge availability and schedule a time to come to campus
- Send people to PDF documents instead of web pages
- Require families to send an email to address frequent, basic questions about your community or admissions process
- Require families to create a login to access basic information or take simple actions

### The Flint Hill Experience by the Numbers

When it comes to pre-K-12 education, size matters. Private schools are uniquely positioned to genuinely get to know our students and differentiate their learning accordingly.

Flint Hill offers:

- 6:1 student-teacher ratio
- 18 student cap for class sizes at every grade level\*
- 200 capacity for the new Peterson Middle School; that's just 100 in 7th grade and 100 in 8th grade
- Middle and Upper School advisory groups have 10-13 students

\*a handful of exceptions apply

#### Financial Aid

We are deeply committed to making a Flint Hill education possible for qualified students, and offer need-based financial aid.

Approximately 20% of Flint Hill students receive need-based financial aid. While we wish we could provide aid to all applicants with demonstrated need, we receive significantly more applications than awards available.

The Financial Aid for Student Tuition (FAST) application for the 2022-23 school is now open. The deadline for new families is January 25, 2022, and the deadline for current families is January 11, 2022. The application typically takes multiple sessions to complete, so we recommend starting early. What are the different ways I can pay my child's tuition?
Flint Hill offers three payment plans for families:
1 Payment Plan – full payment in June
2 Payment Plan - 60% payment due in June, with the remaining 40% due in December
10 Payment Plan – 10 equal payments beginning in June and ending in March






**The Disruptive Pop-Up** 

## **Ineffective Pop-ups**

- Assume intent or try to "close" too quickly
- Appear on the center of a page, disrupting the user experience
- Difficult to close, ability to close is unclear
- Have too many CTAs

## **Effective Pop-ups**

- Appear on action-oriented pages
- Appear to the bottom right
- Close option is clear
- Only ask families to complete one action


