Offering a college preparatory curriculum, the school serves the urban community of the central and west greater Phoenix area. The School's goal seeks to educate its students to be integrated individuals who are spiritually centered Christians, academically prepared students, lifelong learners, effective Communicators and globally aware citizens.

QUALIFICATIONS:

The candidate must be able to communicate effectively with a variety of publics: students, teachers and staff, parents, alumni, community supporters, local pastors and elementary school principals. Candidate must understand Catholic high school students, and be committed to assisting students in the pursuit of academic excellence, strong moral formation, and intentional discipleship. The Principal will report directly to the Diocesan Superintendent.
